Dear Director Marootian:

This is to request a meeting with you as soon as possible to discuss once again removing parking spaces on Reservoir Road in the right turn lane next to Entrance 2 of MedStar Georgetown University Hospital during the morning rush hours.

As you may be aware, for the past several months MedStar Georgetown University Hospital has been working to construct a Surgical Pavilion on the surface parking lot facing Reservoir Road. During this time, DDOT has been extremely helpful in putting in place measures to cut down on traffic back-ups especially during the morning rush hours. The street is limited in terms of space and traffic congestion happens quickly especially at Entrance 2 where our patients must wait in a line to turn into the hospital parking facility. Until this past November when there was a signal installation at that location DDOT temporarily removed the parking spaces during the morning rush hours to allow a more free flowing movement of traffic and avoiding the traffic tie-ups we now see. Once again, either permanently or until construction is completed, eliminating the ability to park from the Entrance 2 driveway back as far as possible toward Foxhall Road is our request and would be appreciated by us and by our community.
