### **RE: Request for the District Department of Transportation to Synchronize the Timing for the Traffic Lights Leading to the Key Bridge**

Dear Mr. Raja,

On April 29, 2019 ANC 2E held its regularly scheduled public meeting, which was properly noticed and attended by six commissioners, constituting a quorum. At this meeting the Commission adopted the following resolution by a vote of (6-0-0) with regard to the above-referenced matter:

ANC 2E notes that Georgetown continues to experience significant congestion, particularly during the PM rush hour and on weekends, as drivers approach the Key Bridge from the east and north. It has been brought to the ANC's attention that the traffic lights on M Street NW from 28th Street to the Key Bridge may have fallen out of synchronization. With this in mind, ANC 2E requests that the District Department of Transportation (DDOT) immediately ensures that the traffic lights from 28th Street to the Key Bridge are synchronized appropriately. Furthermore, ANC 2E requests that DDOT ensures that the lights are timed optimally to ensure (A) pedestrian safety and (B) expediency and efficiency for vehicular traffic heading to the Key Bridge.
