RE: The DC Public Service Commission's Second Hearing on Washington Gas Leaks

Dear Chairman Phillips,

On April 29, 2019 ANC 2E held its regularly scheduled public meeting, which was properly noticed and attended by six commissioners, constituting a quorum. At this meeting the Commission adopted the following resolution by a vote of (6-0-0) with regard to the above-referenced matter:

On February 6, 2019 the Public Service Commission of the District of Columbia (PSC), which regulates the sale and delivery of natural gas in DC, held a public hearing to consider resident concerns about natural gas leaks and repairs and the dissemination of information concerning such work. ANC 2E testified at the hearing given its concerns about the number of gas leaks in our community and the belief that Washington Gas, the public utility that delivers natural gas in the ANC, can improve the quality of both its project management and its public communications concerning repair work.

ANC 2E's February 2019 testimony outlined ten recommendations centered around: (1) improving the quality of communications, (2) improving the quality of project management, and (3) evolving oversight by the PSC. The ten recommendations were based on input from the ANC's constituents and are available to the public.

On May 15, 2019 at 2:00 pm the PSC will hold a second community hearing on natural gas leaks. ANC 2E designates Commissioners Rick Murphy and Gwendolyn Lohse, who represent single member districts 2E03 and 2E06 respectively, to represent the ANC at the PSC's hearing and to testify during the hearing. The commissioners will focus on the progress to date by Washington Gas and the PSC to address the initial ten recommendations submitted by the ANC in February of 2019. Constituents are
