On October 3, 2022 ANC 2E held its regularly scheduled public meeting, which was properly noticed and attended by six commissioners, constituting a quorum. At this meeting the Commission adopted the following resolution by a vote of (6-0-0) with regard to the above-referenced matter:

ANC 2E is proud to work closely with the Citizens Association of Georgetown (CAG) to make Georgetown safer, more beautiful, and more connected. CAG's events bring our community together and get us involved. These events are particularly important post-COVID as we begin to rebuild connections with our friends and neighbors.


Again, ANC 2E strongly supports CAG's permit request.
