### RE: Parking Enforcement in the Neighborhood

Dear Mr. Gaither,

On August 29, 2022 ANC 2E held its regularly scheduled public meeting, which was properly noticed and attended by six commissioners, constituting a quorum. At this meeting the Commission adopted the following resolution by a vote of (6-0-0) with regard to the above-referenced matter:

ANC 2E has issued multiple requests to the Department of Public Works (DPW) for increased parking enforcement, including:

- March 2021: enforcement on 28th Street NW, and
- November 2020: reinstating residential parking enforcement, particularly in Burleith.

Tonight, ANC 2E reiterates its ongoing concerns related to unticketed illegal parking and requests enhanced parking enforcement in three specific areas:

- M Street between 28th Street and 34th Street NW: cars and delivery trucks are frequently double parked along M Street NW between the hours of 9:00 am and 9:00 pm. The double parking is typically related to commercial deliveries and Uber and Lyft drivers although this is by no means the entire problem,
- 28th Street between M Street and Olive Street NW: seven days a week, including during overnight hours, there continues to be illegal parking in the curb lane, both in “no parking” zones as well as in spots exceeding the two-hour residential permit parking (RPP) limits, and

- 31st Street between M Street and South Street NW: especially in the afternoons and early evening on weekdays and weekends, the road becomes impassable as cars and trucks park in “no parking” zones along the southbound travel lane, including on the 31st Street NW bridge. Enforcement is desperately needed to improve both safety and circulation conditions.

ANC 2E requests immediate enhanced attention in these areas to discourage illegal parking as well as ongoing regular enforcement in these key corridors in the ANC’s community.
