RE: Evaluation Methods for the New Bike Lanes on K Street, Water Street, and Wisconsin Avenue NW

Dear Director Marootian and Mr. Zimbabwe,

On July 2, 2018 ANC 2E held its regularly scheduled public meeting, which was properly noticed and attended by five commissioners, constituting a quorum. At this meeting the Commission adopted the following resolution by a vote of (3-2-0) with regard to the above-referenced matter:

ANC 2E understands that over 4,000 bikers enter Water Street NW on an average day, which is equivalent to the vehicular traffic of a minor arterial road in the District like, for instance, M Street from 18th Street to 29th Street NW. ANC 2E wishes to thank the District Department of Transportation (DDOT) for its work on the changes to K Street and Water Street NW via Notice of Intent #17-67-PSD, and the ANC understands that the installation is, at this time, approximately 60% complete. ANC 2E looks forward to 100% completion over the next six weeks and the expected behavioral changes, which the ANC expects to see within another eight weeks thereafter.

With this in mind, ANC 2E reminds DDOT of the request included in our resolution dated September 6, 2017:

Based on the feedback from constituents, as well as significant study of the serious prevailing safety- and traffic-related concerns in the affected areas, ANC 2E supports Notice of Intent #17-67-PSD, provided that within six months of installation, DDOT, in partnership with ANC 2E and the Georgetown Business Improvement District, will objectively evaluate the conditions, with a particular focus on ensuring that the users of the roadway, including, but not limited to,
