RE: Public Safety and Traffic Mitigation During Georgetown University's 2018 Spring Commencement Weekend

Dear Ms. Robinson, Commander Rivera, and Ms. Mitchell,

On April 30, 2018 ANC 2E held its regularly scheduled public meeting, which was properly noticed and attended by seven commissioners, constituting a quorum. At this meeting the Commission adopted the following resolution by a vote of (7-0-0) with regard to the above-referenced matter:

ANC 2E notes that the cumulative effect of increased traffic volume for Georgetown University's commencement activities on Wednesday, May 16th through Sunday, May 20th, combined with the simultaneous closure of the Whitehurst Freeway for the DC Bike Ride and two lanes of the Key Bridge for construction work, plus the potential closure of one lane of Canal Road NW for construction work, will result in significant traffic problems for the Georgetown and Burleith communities and commercial districts.

ANC 2E calls on the District Department of Transportation and other relevant DC Government agencies and bodies to develop solutions that maximize traffic flow on these dates, minimize traffic disruptions and jams in neighborhood streets, and protect public safety. Measures could include keeping important traffic lanes open at critical hours,
