On November 2, 2020 ANC 2E held its regularly scheduled public meeting, which was properly noticed and attended by six commissioners, constituting a quorum. At this meeting the Commission adopted the following resolution by a vote of (6-0-0) with regard to the above-referenced matter:

ANC 2E requests that Mayor Bowser and the DC Council work to address the Department of Motor Vehicles' (DMV) backlog in order to resume residential parking enforcement as soon as possible, especially in the Burleith neighborhood.


