### **RE: Proposed Cuts to DC Circulator Service**

Dear Councilmember Allen,

On April 3, 2023 ANC 2E held its regularly scheduled public meeting, which was properly noticed and attended by seven commissioners, constituting a quorum. At this meeting the Commission adopted the following resolution by a vote of (7-0-0) with regard to the above-referenced matter:

ANC 2E recognizes the vital importance of convenient and reliable public bus service for Georgetown, particularly considering the lack of a Metrorail station. The ANC is alarmed to learn that the Mayor's FY 2024 budget proposal calls for the removal of three DC Circulator bus routes, including the Rosslyn-Dupont Circle route that services M Street NW through Georgetown. The ANC strongly encourages the DC Council to restore the funding for these bus routes in its final budget. The ANC believes that maintaining the DC Circulator bus service through Georgetown at current levels is critical. Residents, employees, and visitors have come to rely on this service and maintaining it is essential to the success of our residential, educational, and business communities.
