RE: Application by Simply Banh Mi for a New Retailer's Class "C" Restaurant License at 1624 Wisconsin Avenue NW, Including a Request for a Stipulated License (ABRA-109779)

Dear Chairperson Anderson,

On June 4, 2018 ANC 2E held its regularly scheduled public meeting, which was properly noticed and attended by six commissioners, constituting a quorum. At this meeting the Commission adopted the following resolution by a vote of (6-0-0) with regard to the above-referenced matter:

WHEREAS, ANC 2E, the Citizens Association of Georgetown, and the owner of Simply Banh Mi have reached a settlement agreement regarding the establishment's application for a new Retailer's Class "C" Restaurant license at 1624 Wisconsin Avenue NW,

WHEREAS, ANC 2E understands that the nature of operation for the establishment will be a new restaurant serving Vietnamese cuisine with a total occupancy load of 24 and seating for 24, and

WHEREAS, ANC 2E understands that the establishment's hours of operation and alcoholic beverage sales, service, and consumption will be Tuesday through Sunday, 11:00 am to 9:00 pm, and closed on Monday.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that ANC 2E protests Simply Banh Mi's application for a new Retailer's Class "C" Restaurant license at 1624 Wisconsin Avenue NW based on adverse impact on the peace, order, and quiet of the neighborhood.
